2 **RULE NULLIFICATION.**

3 The final interagency rule published by the Internal
4 Revenue Service, the Employee Benefits Security Admin-
5 istration, and the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Serv-
6 ices relating to “Short-Term, Limited-Duration Insurance
