A BILL

To repeal title II of the REAL ID Act of 2005 in order
to safeguard civil liberties and individual privacy.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Safeguarding Personal
5 Information Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS FOR DOCU-**
7 **MENTS ACCEPTED FOR FEDERAL IDENTI-**
8 **FICATION PURPOSES.**

9 Title II of the REAL ID Act of 2005 (49 U.S.C.
10 30301 note; division B of Public Law 109–13) is repealed.

1 **SEC. 3. CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.**

2 (a) **BENEFITS FOR AFGHANISTAN NATIONALS.**—Sec-
3 tion 2502(b)(3) of the Afghanistan Supplemental Appro-
4 priations Act, 2022 (8 U.S.C. 1101 note) is amended by
5 striking “under section 202 of the REAL ID Act of 2005
6 (division B of Public Law 109–13; 49 U.S.C. 30301 note),
7 notwithstanding subsection (c)(2)(B) of such Act”.

8 (b) **GRANTS TO STATES.**—Section 475(5)(I) of the
9 Social Security Act(42 U.S.C. 675(5)(I)) is amended by
10 striking “in accordance with the requirements of section
11 202 of the REAL ID Act of 2005”.

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
