A BILL

To nullify certain Executive orders relating to exclusions from Federal labor-management relations programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Protect America’s
3 Workforce Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. NULLIFICATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDERS RELATING**
5 **TO EXCLUSIONS FROM FEDERAL LABOR-MAN-**
6 **AGEMENT RELATIONS PROGRAMS.**

7 Executive Order 14251 (90 Fed. Reg. 14553; relat-
8 ing to exclusions from Federal labor-management rela-
9 tions programs) and Executive Order 14343 (90 Fed.
10 Reg. 42683; relating to further exclusions from the Fed-
11 eral labor-management relations program) shall have no
12 force or effect, and no Federal funds may be obligated
13 or expended to carry out either such Executive order.

14 **SEC. 3. COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS.**

15 Any collective bargaining agreement in effect as of
16 March 26, 2025, between any agency in the executive
17 branch of the Federal Government and any labor organi-
18 zation that is an exclusive representative of Federal em-
19 ployees shall have full force and effect through the stated
20 term of the applicable agreement.

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
