A BILL

To require the Secretary of Transportation to revise requirements relating to triennial highway safety plan submissions, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Streamlining State
5 Highway Safety Submissions Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. STREAMLINING TRIENNIAL HIGHWAY SAFETY PLAN**
7 **SUBMISSIONS.**

8 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
9 of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation shall revise
10 requirements applicable to highway safety programs under

1 section 402 of title 23, United States Code, to allow the
2 completion of a triennial management review conducted by
3 the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to
4 satisfy any information or documentation requirements re-
5 lating to the submission of a triennial highway safety plan
6 under subsection (k) of that section during the period cov-
7 ered by that triennial management review.

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
