Mr. PETERS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

A BILL

To amend the SUPPORT for Patients and Communities Act to reauthorize the youth prevention and recovery initiative, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Youth Prevention and
5 Recovery Reauthorization Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. YOUTH PREVENTION AND RECOVERY.**

7 Section 7102(c) of the SUPPORT for Patients and
8 Communities Act (42 U.S.C. 290bb–7a(c)) is amended—

9 (1) in paragraph (2)—

10 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

1 (i) in clause (i)—

2 (I) by inserting “, or a consor-
3 tium of local educational agencies,”
4 after “a local educational agency”;
5 and

6 (II) by striking “high schools”
7 and inserting “secondary schools”;
8 and

9 (ii) in clause (vi), by striking “tribe,
10 or tribal” and inserting “Tribe, or Tribal”;

11 (B) by amending subparagraph (E) to read
12 as follows:

13 “(E) INDIAN TRIBE; TRIBAL ORGANIZA-
14 TION.—The terms ‘Indian Tribe’ and ‘Tribal
15 organization’ have the meanings given such
16 terms in section 4 of the Indian Self-Deter-
17 mination and Education Assistance Act (25
18 U.S.C. 5304).”;

19 (C) by redesignating subparagraph (K) as
20 subparagraph (L); and

21 (D) by inserting after subparagraph (J)
22 the following:

23 “(K) SECONDARY SCHOOL.—The term
24 ‘secondary school’ has the meaning given such
25 term in section 8101 of the Elementary and

1 Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C.
2 7801).”;

3 (2) in paragraph (3)(A), in the matter pre-
4 ceding clause (i)—

5 (A) by striking “and abuse”; and

6 (B) by inserting “at increased risk for sub-
7 stance misuse” after “specific populations”;

8 (3) in paragraph (4)—

9 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
10 (A), by striking “Indian tribes” and inserting
11 “Indian Tribes”;

12 (B) in subparagraph (A), by striking “and
13 abuse”; and

14 (C) in subparagraph (B), by striking “peer
15 mentoring” and inserting “peer-to-peer sup-
16 port”;

17 (4) in paragraph (5), by striking “tribal” and
18 inserting “Tribal”;

19 (5) in paragraph (6)(A)—

20 (A) in clause (iv), by striking “; and” and
21 inserting a semicolon; and

22 (B) by adding at the end the following:

23 “(vi) a plan to sustain the activities
24 carried out under the grant program, after
25 the grant program has ended; and”;

1 (6) in paragraph (8), by striking “2022” and
2 inserting “2028”; and

3 (7) by amending paragraph (9) to read as fol-
4 lows:

5 “(9) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

6 To carry out this subsection, there are authorized to
7 be appropriated—

8 “(A) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2026;

9 “(B) \$12,000,000 for fiscal year 2027;

10 “(C) \$13,000,000 for fiscal year 2028;

11 “(D) \$14,000,000 for fiscal year 2029;

12 and

13 “(E) \$15,000,000 for fiscal year 2030.”.

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
