Mr. CRUZ (for himself, Mr. YOUNG, and Mrs. BLACKBURN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To permit visiting dignitaries and service members from Taiwan to display the flag of the Republic of China.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT TO PERMIT DIGNITARIES AND**
4 **SERVICE MEMBERS FROM TAIWAN TO DIS-**
5 **PLAY THE FLAG OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of State and the
7 Secretary of Defense shall permit members of the Armed
8 Forces and Government representatives from the Republic
9 of China (Taiwan) or the Taipei Economic and Cultural
10 Representative Office (TECRO) to display, for the official

1 purposes set forth in subsection (b), symbols of Republic
2 of China sovereignty, including—

3 (1) the flag of the Republic of China (Taiwan);

4 and

5 (2) the corresponding emblems or insignia of
6 military units.

7 (b) OFFICIAL PURPOSES.—The official purposes re-
8 ferred to in subsection (a) are—

9 (1) the wearing of official uniforms;

10 (2) conducting government hosted ceremonies
11 or functions; and

12 (3) appearances on Department of State and
13 Department of Defense social media accounts pro-
14 moting engagements with Taiwan.

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
