A BILL

To amend the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 to prohibit contributions and donations by foreign nationals in connection with ballot initiatives and referenda.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Ballot
5 Measures From Foreign Influence Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CONTRIBUTIONS AND DONATIONS**
2 **BY FOREIGN NATIONALS IN CONNECTION**
3 **WITH BALLOT INITIATIVES AND REFERENDA.**

4 (a) PROHIBITION.—Section 319(a)(1)(A) of the Fed-
5 eral Election Campaign Act of 1971 (52 U.S.C.
6 30121(a)(1)(A)) is amended by inserting “, or a State or
7 local ballot initiative or ballot referendum” after “elec-
8 tion”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 this section shall apply with respect to contributions and
11 donations made on or after the date of enactment of this
12 Act.

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
