A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Agriculture to reimburse State agencies for costs incurred in carrying out the supplemental nutrition assistance program during a lapse in appropriations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supplemental Nutri-
5 tion Assistance Program Benefits And Compensation for
6 Keep-up Act of 2025” or the “SNAP BACK Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. SNAP REIMBURSEMENT TO STATES.**

2 The Secretary of Agriculture shall reimburse States
3 for costs incurred in carrying out the supplemental nutri-
4 tion assistance program established under the Food and
5 Nutrition Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 2011 et seq.) during a
6 lapse in appropriations for that program, to the extent
7 that the State carried out that program in accordance with
8 Federal law (including regulations) during that lapse.

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
