A BILL

To amend chapter 171 of title 28, United States Code, to prohibit the President from seeking relief under that chapter.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Torts for Trump
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXCEPTIONS TO FEDERAL TORT CLAIMS ACT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2680 of title 28, United
8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
9 lowing:

1 “(o) Any claim, without regard to when the act or
2 omission giving rise to the claim occurred, brought by—

3 “(1) the President; or

4 “(2) an individual who subsequently becomes
5 President while the claim is pending.”.

6 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-
7 section (a) shall apply to any claim pending on, or brought
8 on or after, the date of enactment of this Act.

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
