Ms. ERNST (for herself and Ms. CORTEZ MASTO) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To repeal the reduced postage rate for qualified political
committees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ending Subsidies for
5 Political Junk Mail Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF REDUCED POSTAGE RATE FOR QUALI-**
7 **FIED POLITICAL COMMITTEES.**

8 Section 3626 of title 39, United States Code, is
9 amended—

10 (1) by striking subsection (e);

1 (2) by redesignating subsections (f), (g), and
2 (h) as subsections (e), (f), and (g), respectively;

3 (3) by redesignating subsections (j) through (n)
4 as subsections (h) through (l), respectively; and

5 (4) in subsection (h), as redesignated by para-
6 graph (3)—

7 (A) in paragraph (1)(D), by striking “sub-
8 section (m)(2)” and inserting “subsection
9 (k)(2)”; and

10 (B) in paragraph (3)(B), by striking “sub-
11 section (m)” and inserting “subsection (k)”.

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
