Mr. PETERS (for himself and Ms. ERNST) introduced the following bill; which
was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and
Transportation

A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, with respect to
motorcyclist safety, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Motorcycle Safety
5 Awareness Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. MOTORCYCLIST SAFETY.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 405(f)(3) of title 23,
8 United States Code, is amended—

9 (1) in the matter preceding subparagraph (A),
10 by striking “at least 2 of the following criteria” and

1 inserting “at least 3 of the following criteria, 1 of
 2 which shall be the criterion described in subpara-
 3 graph (H)”; and

4 (2) by adding at the end the following:

5 “(H) DRIVER EDUCATION AND DRIVING
 6 SAFETY COURSES.—The inclusion, in driver
 7 education and driver safety courses provided to
 8 individuals by educational and motor vehicle
 9 agencies of the State, of instruction and testing
 10 relating to motorcyclist awareness, including in-
 11 formation relating to—

12 “(i) State-specific motorcycle laws,
 13 such as lane-splitting and lane-filtering
 14 laws; and

15 “(ii) share-the-road principles in-
 16 tended to increase awareness of motorcy-
 17 clists and scooter riders on the roadway.”.

18 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 19 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date that is 2 years
 20 after the date of enactment of this Act.

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
