Mr. YOUNG introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Select Committee on Intelligence

A BILL

To require the Director of National Intelligence to develop a strategy on intelligence coordination and sharing relating to critical and emerging technologies.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. STRATEGY ON INTELLIGENCE COORDINATION**
4 **AND SHARING RELATING TO CRITICAL AND**
5 **EMERGING TECHNOLOGIES.**

6 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the terms “con-
7 gressional intelligence committees” and “intelligence com-
8 munity” have the meanings given such terms in section
9 3 of the National Security Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3003).

1 (b) STRATEGY.—Not later than 60 days after the
2 date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of National
3 Intelligence shall develop a strategy for—

4 (1) coordinating the collection, processing, anal-
5 ysis, and dissemination of foreign intelligence relat-
6 ing to critical and emerging technologies across the
7 intelligence community; and

8 (2) the appropriate sharing of such intelligence
9 with other Federal departments and agencies with
10 responsibilities for regulation, innovation and re-
11 search, science, public health, export control and
12 screenings, and Federal financial tools.

13 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 30 days after the devel-
14 opment of the strategy required by subsection (b), the Di-
15 rector shall submit to the congressional intelligence com-
16 mittees a copy of the strategy.
