Mr. LUJÁN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry

A BILL

To provide additional funds to States for administration of certain nutrition programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Nutrition Administra-
5 tion Assistance Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR ADMINISTRATION COSTS.**

7 (a) COMMODITY SUPPLEMENTAL FOOD PROGRAM.—

8 In addition to funds otherwise made available to State
9 agencies to pay administration costs incurred by State
10 agencies to carry out section 5 of the Agriculture and Con-

1 sumer Protection Act of 1973 (7 U.S.C. 612c note), 70
 2 percent of the funds appropriated under section 3 shall
 3 be provided to States for such administration costs.

4 (b) EMERGENCY FOOD ASSISTANCE ACT OF 1983.—

5 In addition to funds otherwise made available to States
 6 to pay administration costs incurred by States to carry
 7 out State plans under section 203A of the Emergency
 8 Food Assistance Act of 1983 (7 U.S.C. 7504), 20 percent
 9 of the funds appropriated under section 3 shall be pro-
 10 vided to States for such administration costs.

11 (c) SENIORS FARMERS' MARKET NUTRITION PRO-

12 GRAM.—In addition to funds otherwise made available to
 13 the Secretary of Agriculture for administration costs to
 14 carry out section 4402 of the Farm Security and Rural
 15 Investment Act of 2002 (7 U.S.C. 3007), 10 percent of
 16 the funds appropriated under section 3 shall be provided
 17 to States for such administration costs.

18 **SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

19 There is authorized to be appropriated to carry out
 20 this Act \$1,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2026
 21 through 2030.

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
