A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to protect U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement agents, as well as other Federal law enforcement officers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “ICE Protection Act
5 of 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROTECTION OF ICE AGENTS FROM VEHICLES.**

2 Section 111 of title 18, United States Code, is
 3 amended by striking subsection (b) and inserting the fol-
 4 lowing:

5 “(b) ENHANCED PENALTIES.—

6 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2),
 7 whoever, in the commission of an act described in
 8 subsection (a), uses a deadly or dangerous weapon
 9 (including a weapon that is intended to cause death
 10 or danger but fails to do so by reason of a defective
 11 component) or inflicts bodily injury, shall be fined
 12 under this title or imprisoned not more than 40
 13 years, or both.

14 “(2) USE OF MOTOR VEHICLE.—If the deadly
 15 or dangerous weapon (including a weapon that is in-
 16 tended to cause death or danger but fails to do so
 17 by reason of a defective component) used to commit
 18 an act described in subsection (a) is a motor vehicle,
 19 and the act results in—

20 “(A) bodily injury (as defined in section
 21 1365), the defendant shall be imprisoned not
 22 less than 5 years;

23 “(B) substantial bodily injury (as defined
 24 in section 113), the defendant shall be impris-
 25 oned not less than 7 years; or

1 “(C) serious bodily injury (as defined in
2 section 1365), the defendant shall be impris-
3 oned not less than 10 years.”.

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
