Mr. WYDEN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Select Committee on Intelligence

A BILL

To amend the FISA Amendments Act of 2008 to extend the authorities of title VII of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance Act of 1978 through May 21, 2026, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PUBLIC RELEASE OF FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE**
4 **SURVEILLANCE COURT OPINION RELATED**
5 **TO SECTION 702 CERTIFICATIONS.**

6 As soon as practicable, but not later than May 12,
7 2026, the Director of National Intelligence, in consulta-
8 tion with the Attorney General, shall publicly release the

1 Memorandum Opinion and Order of the Foreign Intel-
 2 ligence Surveillance Court dated March 17, 2026, regard-
 3 ing section 702 of the Foreign Intelligence Surveillance
 4 Act of 1978 (50 U.S.C. 1881a), with such redactions as
 5 may be necessary to protect intelligence sources and meth-
 6 ods.

7 **SEC. 2. THREE-WEEK EXTENSION OF AUTHORITIES OF**
 8 **TITLE VII OF THE FOREIGN INTELLIGENCE**
 9 **SURVEILLANCE ACT OF 1978.**

10 (a) EXTENSION OF REPEAL DATE OF TITLE VII.—
 11 Section 403(b) of the FISA Amendments Act of 2008
 12 (Public Law 110–261) is amended—

13 (1) in paragraph (1) (50 U.S.C. 1881 note), by
 14 striking “April 30, 2026” and inserting “May 21,
 15 2026”; and

16 (2) in paragraph (2) (18 U.S.C. 2511 note), in
 17 the matter preceding subparagraph (A), by striking
 18 “April 30, 2026” and inserting “May 21, 2026”.

19 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
 20 this section shall take effect on the earlier of the date of
 21 the enactment of this Act or April 29, 2026.
