Mrs. HYDE-SMITH (for herself, Mrs. BRITT, and Mr. KENNEDY) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To require the United States Executive Directors at the international financial institutions to oppose certain projects involving shrimp production.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Save Our Shrimpers
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. VOICE AND VOTE REQUIREMENT.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treasury
8 shall instruct the United States Executive Director at each
9 international financial institution (as defined in section

1 1701(c)(2) of the International Financial Institutions Act)
2 to use the voice and vote of the United States to oppose
3 any financial assistance by such institution for any project
4 to support shrimp farming, shrimp processing, or the ex-
5 port of shrimp in a borrowing country.

6 (b) WAIVER AUTHORITY.—The Secretary of the
7 Treasury may waive subsection (a) with respect to a
8 project upon notifying the Congress that the waiver is in
9 the national interest of the United States.

10 (c) EXPIRATION.—Subsection (a) shall have no force
11 or effect after the end of the 7-year period beginning on
12 the date of enactment of this Act.

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
