A BILL

To amend the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 to make fertilizer storage facilities eligible for farm storage facility loans, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Building Infrastruc-
5 ture for Nutrient Storage Act of 2026” or the “BINS Act
6 of 2026”.

7 **SEC. 2. STORAGE FACILITY LOANS.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1614(a) of the Food, Con-
9 servation, and Energy Act of 2008 (7 U.S.C. 8789(a)) is

1 amended by inserting “fertilizer,” after “renewable bio-
2 mass,”.

3 (b) RULEMAKING.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture
5 shall amend part 1436 of title 7, Code of Federal Regula-
6 tions, to reflect the amendment made by subsection (a),
7 including to ensure that, with respect to fertilizer, loans
8 may be made under the Farm Storage Facility Loan Pro-
9 gram for, at a minimum, the following:

10 (1) Dry bins and dry flat storage.

11 (2) Fertilizer blenders.

12 (3) Liquid tanks.

13 (4) Anhydrous ammonia pressure vessels.

14 (5) Foundations, electrical systems, conveyors,
15 plumbing, piping, and pumps necessary for the re-
16 ceipt, storage, and removal of fertilizer products.

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
