A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the program relating to lifespan respite care, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Lifespan Respite Care
5 Reauthorization Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF LIFESPAN RESPITE CARE**
7 **PROGRAM.**

8 (a) DEFINITION OF FAMILY CAREGIVER.—Section
9 2901(5) of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C.

1 300ii(5)) is amended by striking “unpaid adult” and in-
2 serting “unpaid individual”.

3 (b) FUNDING.—Section 2905 of the Public Health
4 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300ii–4) is amended by striking
5 “fiscal years 2020 through fiscal year 2024” and inserting
6 “fiscal years 2025 through 2030”.
